- A He usually painted using oils, but he liked to vary things and sometimes used watercolours. He loved to paint people, and produced a beautiful portrait of his mother. Many people believe that his real masterpiece was *Guernica*, which he painted during the Spanish Civil War.
- B His music appeals to people because of the rhythm and melodies, but people also admire him for his work in politics and for social causes.
- C Agatha Christie is possibly the world's most famous detective story writer. She wrote 79 novels and several plays. Her sales outnumbered those of William Shakespeare. However, behind her successful writing career was a painfully shy woman whose life was often lonely and unhappy.
- D In 1975, he made *Jaws*, which was very successful, and made him rich and famous. Since then, he has made more than thirty films, including box office hits *Close Encounters*, *Indiana Jones*, *ET*, and *Jurassic Park*. He also directed more serious movies, like *Saving Private Ryan* and *Schindler's List*, and has also produced a lot of blockbusters.
- E Gilberto Gil is a Brazilian singer and guitarist, and one of his country's most talented songwriters. As a young musician in the 1950s, he was influenced by the bossa nova style, but he didn't release his first album, *Louvação*, until 1967.
- F In the past, the painting was on display in exhibitions all over the world, but now it is permanently in Madrid's Reina Sofia Museum.
- G Steven Spielberg is one of the most important filmmakers of the late 20th century, and in his career he has earned millions of dollars. He's been making movies since he was 13 when he made a war film, *Escape to Nowhere*. He studied English Literature at California State University because he couldn't get into film school.
- H During World War 1, while she was working in a hospital dispensary, she learned about chemicals and poisons, which proved to be very useful to her in her later career. In 1920 she wrote her first detective novel *The Mysterious Affair at Styles* in which she introduced Hercule Poirot, the Belgian detective who appeared in many subsequent novels.
- I He travelled in the 1970s, recorded an album in English, and, in 1980, introduced reggae to Brazil with his recording of the Bob Marley song, 'No woman, no cry'. He has played with many musicians, while continuing his career as a solo artist. In all he has produced over 40 albums.
- J Picasso was a great artist who worked in a variety of different styles, some realistic and others abstract. He developed a wide range of painting techniques.
- K In 1994 he formed his own film studio – Dreamworks SKG. Recently, Dreamworks has been working with Microsoft to produce interactive games and videos.
- L She was born in 1890 in Devon and grew into a beautiful and sensitive girl with waist-length golden hair. Her father died when she was 11 and both she and her mother were grief-stricken.
